

Ice House Customers,

As of Monday, November 29th, the overflow parking area at the far end of the construction site **will no longer be available**. Instead, overflow parking will be directed to **two areas in Foschini Park** and a **third area on Midtown Bridge**. The map on the following page clearly lays out how customers should approach parking along with drop-off and pick-up for players/skaters:

Access to the smaller of the two parking areas in Foschini Park can be found by turning off of Salem Street (which is a two-way). Access to the larger of the two parking areas in Foschini Park for can be found by turning off of River Street and onto East Camden (*which is a one-way*).

Please note that the smaller parking area can be accessed from both directions, but the larger parking area can only be accessed from River St. The **red arrows** indicate the path to take for parking, and the **green arrows** indicate the path to take for pick-up.

Also, as indicated in the map below, a **closer parking area** on Midtown Bridge is **now available to all Ice House customers**.

While we understand the inconvenience of these current updates, we want to excitedly inform you that the covered parking garage across the street will be ready/accessible by late Winter/early Spring of 2022.
