TIER II TEAMS

8U AAA Blizzard (AHF Full-Ice Mite)

- **Tryouts:** March 26, 27, 28: start time 500 PM

8U AAA - BLIZZARD BLUE (2016) / BLIZZARD WHITE (2016/2017)

- **Spring** - one practice per week on Thursday evening. Attend AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
- **Summer** – team on ice training sessions will begin late August in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 30-Sept 2
- **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 60 min practices per week on Tuesday and Thursday evenings
- Approximately 35-45 games
- Teams will play in the AHF full ice league
- Teams will attend AHF Showcases and Tournament events (3 or 4 season total)
- AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
- Player Tuition \$4400 (\$2200 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)
- Goaltenders \$1000 (payment in full when signing player contract)

8U B (2016-2019)

- **Tryouts:** March 26, 27, 28: start time 500 PM
 - **Spring** - one practice per week on Monday evening
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 60 min practices per week on Monday and Wednesday evenings
 - 8U B teams will play games at the Ice House on Sunday mornings. Games will grow from ½ ice to ¾ ice to full ice as the season and development progresses
 - Player Tuition \$3200 (\$1600 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)
 - Goaltenders \$1000 (payment in full when signing player contract)

10U AA, 10U A (2014/2015)

- **Tryouts:** March 26, 27, 28: start time 615 PM
 - **Spring** - one practice per week on Monday evening. Attend AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
 - **Summer** - team on ice training sessions will begin late August in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 23-25 for 10U A and Aug 30-Sept 2 for 10U AA
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Monday and Wednesday evenings
 - Approximately 40-50 games
 - Teams will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation
 - Teams will attend AHF Showcases and Tournament events (3 or 4 season total)
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - Tuition \$4850 (\$2425 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)
 - Goaltenders \$2425 (payment in full when signing player contract)

12U AA (2012), 12UA, (2012/2013), 11AA (2013)

 - **Spring** – one practice per week in the spring on Tuesday evening. Attend AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
 - **Summer** - team on ice training sessions will begin late august in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 23-25 for 12U A and Aug 30-Sept 2 for 12U AA/11AA
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Monday and Wednesday evenings.
 - Approximately 40-50 games
 - Teams will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation
 - Teams will attend AHF Showcases and Tournament events (3 or 4 season total)
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - Tuition \$4950 (\$2475 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)

13U AA (2011)

- **Tryouts:** April 15, 16, 17: start time 600 PM
 - **Spring** – this team will practice twice prior to attending the AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
 - **Summer** - team on ice training sessions will begin late august in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 30-Sept 2
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, with a full ice component each week
 - Also, in-season, a 60 min skill session on most Wednesdays (15 in total) with Nates Euro Hockey company.
 - Approximately 45-55 games
 - The team will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation
 - The team will attend a total of three AHF Showcases and two additional tournaments.
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - Tuition \$5800 (\$2900 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)

14U AA (2010)

- **Tryouts:** April 15, 16, 17: start time 600 PM
 - **Spring** — this team will practice twice prior to attending the AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
 - **Summer** - team on ice training sessions will begin late august in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 30 -Sept 2
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, with a full ice component each week

 - Approximately 35-45 games
 - Teams will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation.
 - Teams will attend two Atlantic Hockey Federation Showcases and two additional tournaments
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - 15 AA Tuition \$4500 (\$3000 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due Aug 1, 2024)

16U AA* (2008), 16U A (2008/2009), 18U AA*, 18U A* (2006/2007) Short Season

*Short season teams - season concludes by the end of November prior to the start of High School season

- **Tryouts:** April 15, 16, 17: start time 800 PM
 - **Spring** – teams will practice twice prior to attending AHF parity Event April 27 or 28
 - **Summer** - team on ice training sessions will begin late august in preparation for the first AHF showcase which will be the weekend of Aug 23-25 for 16A/18U A and Aug 30-Sept 2 for 16U AA/18U AA
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Monday and Wednesday evenings
 - Approximately 25-30 games
 - Teams will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation
 - Teams will attend two Atlantic Hockey Federation Showcases
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - Districts (date TBD)
 - 16U and 18U Tuition \$2950 (Payment in full when signing player contract)

14U Girls (2010-2012)

- **Tryouts:** April 15, 16, 17: start time 630 PM
 - **Spring** – one practice per week in the spring on Tuesday evening.
 - **In-season** – beginning after Labor Day, beginning after Labor Day, two 75 min practices per week on Monday and Wednesday evenings, with a full ice component each week
 - Approximately 45-55 games
 - Teams will compete in the Atlantic Hockey Federation
 - Teams will attend AHF Showcases and Tournament events (3 or 4 season total).
 - AHF Playoffs (date TBD)
 - Tuition \$5100 (\$2550 Deposit due when signing player contract/Remaining balance due by Aug 1, 2024)
